5. Participation Qualification:

- Participating countries or territories must be member of IBAD.
- Participating players must be citizens of the countries or territories.

6. Participation Quotas per country/ territory:

- Singles: Maximum of 6 players for each Event per country / territory
- Doubles: Maximum of 3 pairs for each Event per country / territory

7. Umpires:

We would like to invite one qualified umpire from each participating Country / territory.

His or her board and lodging during the competition will be taken care of by the Organizing committee.

8. Rules and Regulations:

The current rules of BWF and IBAD (2005 – 2008)

Shuttlecocks to be used: Yonex AS50

9, entry/Participation Fee: all athletes and official staffs are free for meals and accommodation.

10. Airport: Incheon airport, Seoul, Korea

11. Participant's arriving and leaving: Arrive on 07 July (Monday) and leave on 13 July (Sunday). During this period, local transportation can be provided, and accommodation and meals will be available from dinner on 07 July until breakfast on 13 July.

Any arrival and departure before and after the dates stated above shall be arranged by participant.

12. Protest:

- Appeals must be in writing with a deposit of EUR100. Refund will be made only when the referee meeting approves that the protest is sustained.
- Any matters relating to the player's qualification
- must be raised within 30 minutes after the player's classification is made /completed.
- Appeals must be raised within 30 minutes after each game.
- Over the time limit of 30 minutes, appeals will not be accepted.
- The deposit of appeals will only be returned if the appeals are approved on the decision by the Judgment Committee.
- The members of the Judgments Committee are includes representatives from the technical representative, the Chief of Competition, the Chief of Judgment and the Classifier.

13. Judgment of the protest:

The appeal is similar or same as the rules of BWF, the judgment is made by the games officials.

Without showing on the I.B.A.D rules, the final judgment of the appeals would be decided by the Judgment Committee.
